- You have experience teaching and training others in ADR methods and issues and/or custody evaluations.
- You have substantial experience working in family law and related issues.
- You have substantial experience participating in different forms of ADR and/or custody evaluations.
- You have experience designing curriculum for training in ADR and/or custody evaluations.
- You can use different platforms for online and in person training.
- You can critique the work of students and provide meaningful feedback.
